



# Literacy Stations

## Set 21

1. **Listening Center:** Students will listen to Hedgie's Surprise, by Jan Brett. After listening to the story, they will complete a short story report.
2. **Weather:** Students will create a foggy day picture. They will draw an "outside" picture on white paper. This paper will be glued a piece of gray construction paper. A piece of waxed paper will be attached on top of the picture to make it look "foggy".
3. **Animals:** Students will use sequins to represent scales on a paper snake pattern. This is the fourth of five animal coverings projects the students will do.
4. **USA:** Students will use a map of USA to complete a paper. Students have to imagine that they are in Kansas. They will write three states in which they could travel to if they were going to the east, to the west, to the north, to the south.
5. **Spelling:** Students will use gel pens on black paper to write each spelling word in a pyramid form.
6. **Computers:** Students will use Ultimate Writing Center to type three sentences about reptiles.
